## Instructions for Logging into the Research Workspace


If you are already a member of the Research Workspace (RW), log into your account at: <https://researchworkspace.com>. Then follow the below steps to clone a project.

If you are not a RW member, follow these instructions to create a new account.

### Create a New Account

All members of the RW have a secure account. If it's your first time using the RW:

1. Go to <https://researchworkspace.com>,

2. Click  button

3. Click 'Create Account'.

4. Use access code: workspace2018


5. Enter email address and password

(or click the  button if your email is Google-authorized).

### Clone a Project

To clone the example project that will be used during the workshop follow these steps:

1. On the left hand side of the screen, click on the Activity Feed icon .
2. Under the Campaigns, click "View All" and open "SECOORA 2018 Workshop Notebooks".
3. Hover over the "SECOORA 2018 Workshop Example" project and click on the 3 gray dots on the right-hand side of the project listing.



4. Select 'Clone' from the dropdown menu that appears.
5. A pop-up window will confirm that the project is being cloned.
6. After the project has been cloned, click on the Activity Feed icon  and select 'My Projects'.
7. Click on "SECOORA 2018 Workshop Example" to now open your copy of the project.
