





## Outcome-oriented



- Land use planning approach
- Policies that guide redevelopment
- Should we rebuild in a different way?
- How should we spend the money?

# Resilience

- Recovery: Long-term rebuilding and restoring built and natural environment after disaster
- Resilience: Ability for social, natural, and built environment systems to bounce back after disaster or cope with long-term change
- Where is the overlap?
  - More resilient businesses and communities have fewer recovery needs
  - There are opportunities to improve resilience in disaster recovery
- Climate resilience: Overlaps with disaster resilience but also includes slow changes like sea level rise


