- GOAL 1** **Support priority projects in NC, SC, GA, and FL** that enhance the ability of coastal communities to prepare for disaster recovery
- GOAL 2** **Build the capacity and relationships for businesses** to recover
- GOAL 3** **Build regional capacity** for disaster recovery planning

Where we are now

Activities

- State agencies applied for funds to do a priority project in concert with Partnership
 - Initial focus on NDRF has broadened
- Resilient business
 - Outreach: Small, dedicated leadership team
 - Research: One white paper released, another on the way
- Regional community of practice
 - Annual meetings, monthly calls, share resources via email, Twitter

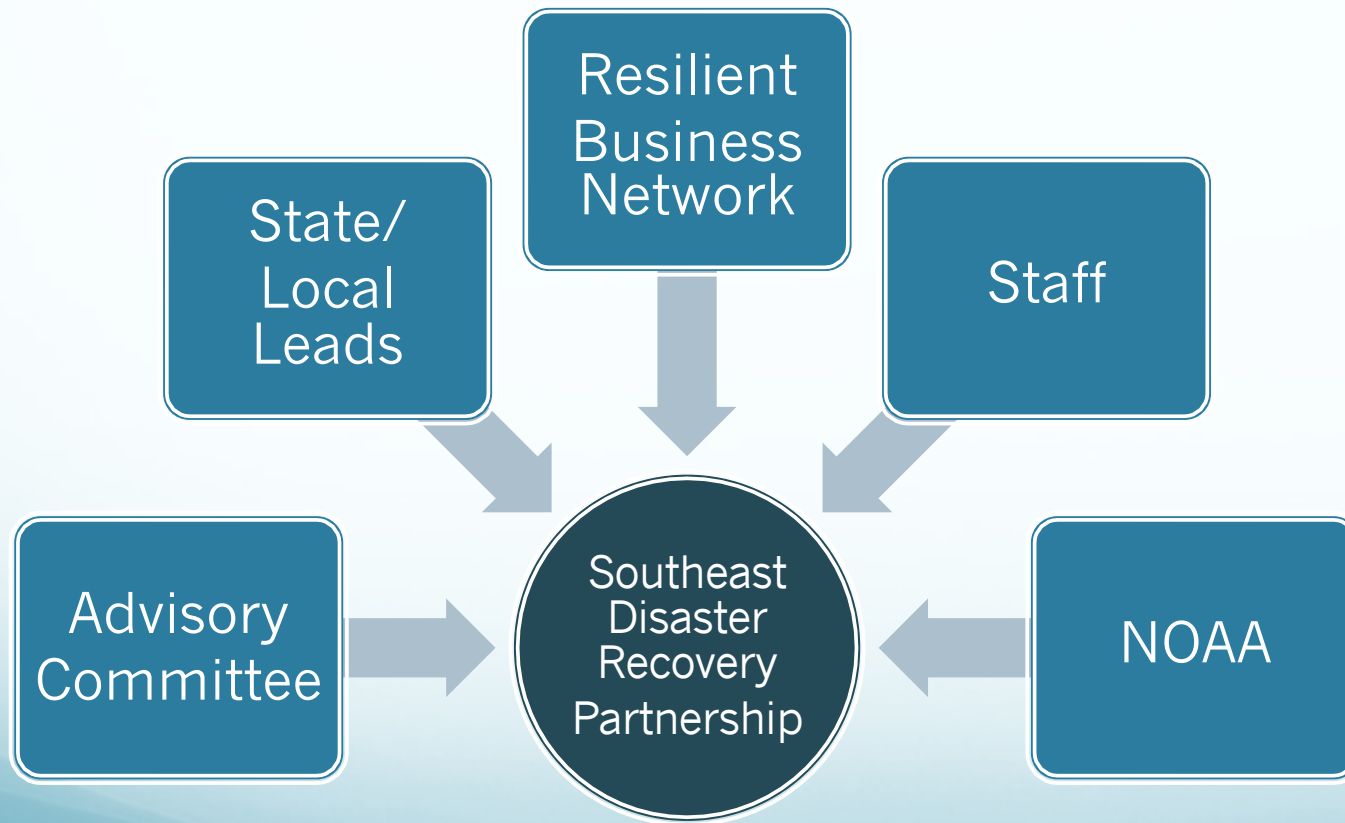


**Regional Coastal
Resilience Grant Awards**

- \$800K + \$400K leveraged or “match”
- State projects: \$600K
- Private sector/economic recovery and regional collaboration: \$200K
- Challenge of relying on large federal grants
- Our partners’ time + expertise
 - Momentum and several committed partners
 - Challenge of a voluntary partnership and of turnover
