In remembrance of Vembu Subramanian – a friend and colleague – Southeast Coastal Ocean Observing Regional Association (SECOORA) is establishing an award for the next generation of ocean experts.

Opportunity

SECOORA is continuing Vembu's mentoring legacy by sponsoring the annual Ocean Scholars Award. **The award value for 2019 is \$3500.**

This award will be provided to one undergraduate student, graduate student, or early career professional to **support their research and to provide travel support to present at a regional or national meeting or conference.**

All proposals must be relevant to a SECOORA focus area.

Who can apply?

- Students must be enrolled towards a degree in a full-time undergraduate or graduate program and must have at least a 3.2 cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 scale. Students must be enrolled at a SECOORA member institution and enrolled as a student in the spring semester of 2019.
- Early career professionals are those that have been working less than five years from their college graduation date and he/she must be working at a SECOORA member institution.
