

- The addition of these sites to the IOOS HFR National Network will provide surface current velocity and wave measurement coverage to enhance maritime safety and forecasting throughout the area.



Program Highlights and Plans for FY24

- HFR: HFRNet DAC; HFRs to telemeter surface wave measurements at test sites; new HFR site at NASA KSC and recap at Cape Canaveral bringing coverage to Florida's Space Coast
- **Gliders**: MOA for Navy/IOOS hurricane glider collaboration; Sep. UG2 Workshop
- **COMT**: Will be announced in June
- Marine Life: White house to announce National Ocean Biodiversity Strategy and National Aquatic eDNA Strategy in June
- NHABON FY24 \$3.0M announced May 2, 2024. SECOORA awarded funding for Sargassum project with GCOOS and CARICOOS
- Grant Support: BIL and IRA RFA opportunities and moving all the money that we can!




